# **STRENGTHEN**




#### \$5 MILLION

Restoration to ensure baseline funding for the Advantage After School Program

#### \$169 MILLION

- Bridge investment to align per student rate of state afterschool programs to \$4,300 for one year
- Statutory language for Empire State After-School Program amended to increase the per student rate

## **ENHANCE**



#### \$250,000

New line-item fund to the statewide afterschool network. NYS Network for Youth Success, to provide TA and capacity building supports

#### \$3 MILLION

For the Educational Incentive Program to expand scholarships to child care workers

# **TRANSFORM**

#### \$500 MILLION

Child Care Investment Fund for competitive wages & professional development for child care professionals

## \$6.9 BILLION

Over the next <u>five years</u> to provide access to afterschool for every New York child that needs it

#### **STREAMLINED**

Contract process for timely payments to afterschool grantees

#### CHILDCARE FOR ALL FAMILIES

That prioritizes school-age children as well in the vision of universal child care

#### **COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS**

Through incentives for school district to work with community-based, youth, and family serving organizations to address learning loss

#### **CLEAR STANDARDS**

To ensure accountability and transparency in the utilization of stimulus education dollars
