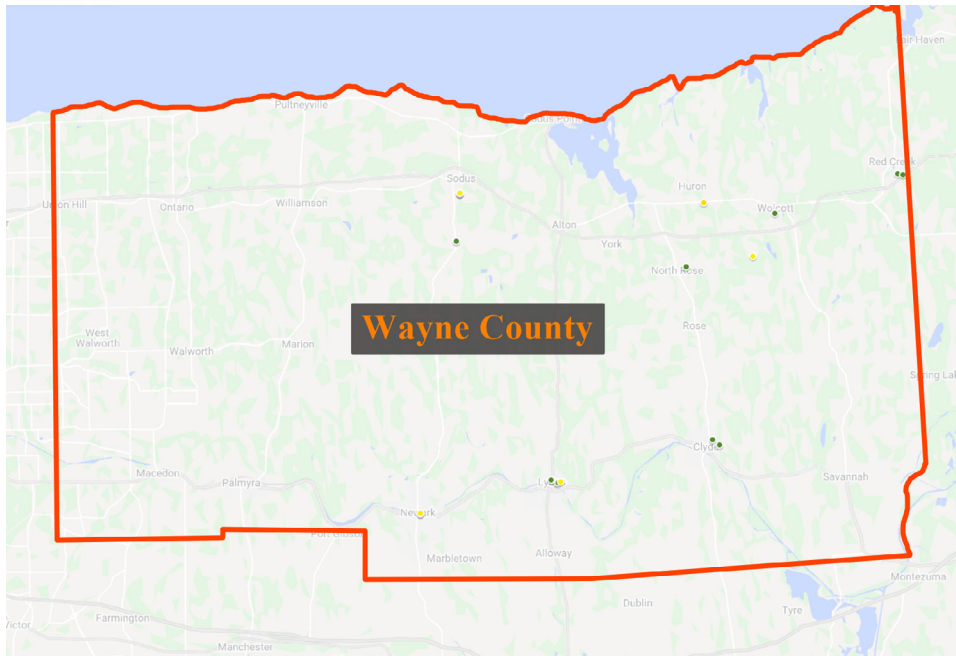

of New York parents/caregivers are in favor of funding for programs that provide afterschool opportunities.



## 33%

of children participating in afterschool in New York are from low-income households.
